Duties

Sports coaches at the California School for the Blind will be responsible for advertising their sport to our school community, coordinating tryouts, planning and facilitating daily practices and no less than three meets/events/games or tournaments per sport/season.

Desired Qualifications

Coach should have the necessary knowledge to teach and develop individual sport fundamentals and team skills appropriate to the age and competition level of the team.

Who May Apply

Individuals currently employed within California State Service who are in Collective Bargaining Unit 3 are given preference however in the absence of a qualified Unit 3 applicant anyone else is eligible.

Essential Elements

- Coach is responsible for planning for and conducting daily practices and training sessions as well as planned try-out and/or conditioning.
- Coach is responsible for planning, coordinating, and coaching no less than three meets/events/games or tournaments per season.
- Coach is responsible for maintaining and/or developing the necessary knowledge to teach and develop individual and team skills appropriate to the age and competition level of the team.
- Collaborate with other coaches to maximize participation and commitment from student athletes.
- Attend coaching meetings

- Proposed Season schedules are as follows:
 - Fall 2020 = August 24 to November 9 (40 practice sessions)
 - Winter 2020-2021 = November 9 to February 16 (40 practice sessions)
 - Spring 2021 = February 16 to May 6 (40 practice sessions)
 - Daily practices no less than 1 hour per day Monday through Thursday for days indicated in season calendar.

A job offer will be made contingent upon a final budget being approved by the State Legislature and the Governor that allows for full funding of this position. Current or future executive orders relative to filling vacant positions may also affect this process.
